## CONFERENCE OBJECTIVES:

1. Define “spirit” as it relates to self and to healthcare service. Discover how empathy affects leadership and list four ways empathy affects leadership. 4. Define metastasis and discuss the impact of metastatic disease on organ function. Discuss the impact bone metastasis has on quality of life.
5. List the elements of USP General Chapter <800> that provides standards for safe handling of hazardous drugs to minimize the risk of exposure to healthcare personnel, patients and the environment. Discuss how safe handling practices for hazardous drugs requires multidisciplinary collaboration.
6. Describe how evidence-based practice translates into safer bedside care and more desirable clinical outcomes.
7. Discuss the advances in the diagnosis of gastrointestinal cancers. Discuss four trends in the treatment of gastrointestinal cancers. Discuss the nurse’s role in assessing patients undergoing the most recent trends in gastrointestinal cancers.
